# What is NCYC

- The National Catholic Youth Conference is a 3 day conference for filled with Prayer, Community, Leadership, Empowerment, the Eucharist, Fun, Food, etc. that is offered every other year. This fall it will be offered in Indy from Nov 21-23.
- I tell everyone to think of it as a 4 day conference as we will not travel home until Sunday so Nov 21-24
- The schedule is jam packed but you have the flexibility to pick your sessions during Friday & Saturday – you go to the session that answers your questions or speaks to where you are in your faith journey.

 We bus out on Thursday to head to Indy and spend the evening with a Mass, a concert, meeting our Emcee's, and a Keynote speaker will present. Friday will begin with music/dancing and a Keynote speaker before we head to smaller group sessions until we come back together for dinner, a concert, a keynote speaker and adoration.
