Real You

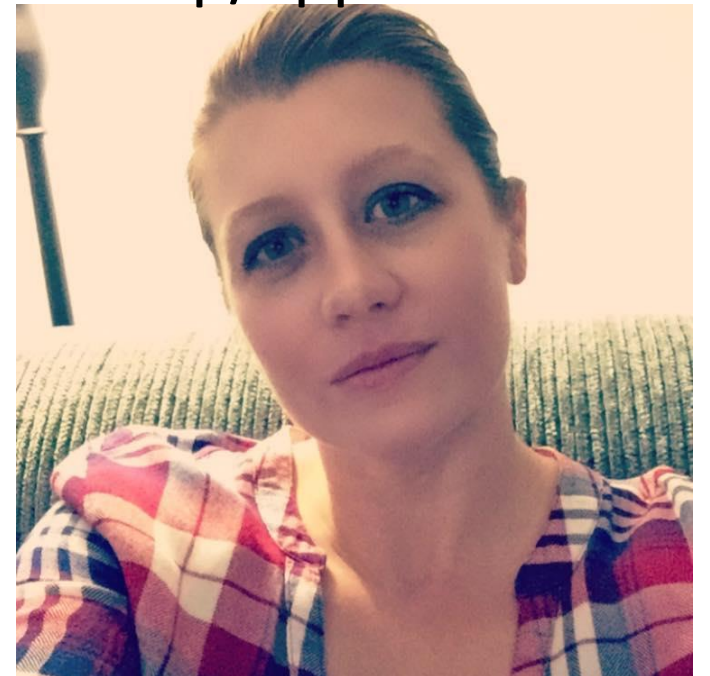

What does the Bible say about it?

- Matthew 5:48 “Be perfect, therefore as your heavenly Father is perfect”
- Romans 12:2 “Do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God – what is good and acceptable and perfect.”
- Philippians 2:3-5 “Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interest, but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus.”
- 1 Peter 5:6 “Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, so that he may exult you in due time.”

Reflections on the Bible Verses

- Matthew – this is the biggest challenge and one that many of us have forgotten. Fr Eric spoke about Mark Hart's Sunday podcast and this weekend something in it struck me. Someone once asked him if he was trying to get to Heaven or just to avoid Hell. We forget that the first is our goal and live like the second.
- Romans – Honestly, this is a huge challenge too – especially when it comes to the ability to have such knowledge at our fingertips – which is good and bad. We can use it to renew our minds but it can also fill our mind with un-Godly thoughts. Try to conform yourself into the you God sees and desires you to be – not who the world says you should be.
- Philippians – I want you to look at 2 points from this scripture “in humility regard others as better than yourselves” or be a good friend and make sure it isn't all about you. And “let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus” so again look to love and care for others.
- Anyone hear about the JOY mindset – Jesus, Others, You.
- Peter – again Humble yourselves so that God may exult you (beatitudes)
- There are many other verses that you can find that speak to presenting yourself in truth and love – God loves the you He created so you should let your true self shine.
